Topics for Early Clinical exposure

Upper Limb

1. Examination of radial pulse & Blood pressure
2. Taking blood sample from Median cubital vein
3. Applied anatomy of shoulder joint and elbow joint
4. Carpal tunnel syndrome
5. Clinical anatomy of upper limb

Lower limb

1. Varicose vein
2. Applied anatomy of knee joint and arches of foot
3. Intramuscular injections: Gluteal region
4. Lumbar puncture
5. Venesection
6. Clinical anatomy of lower limb

Thorax

1. Intracardiac injection
2. Examination of respiratory system: breath sound
3. Examination of circulatory system: heart sound
4. Percussion
5. Auscultation
6. Coronary angiography: through open lumen of femoral artery
7. Clinical anatomy of heart

Abdomen

1. Methods of clinical examination: inspection, palpation, percussion, auscultation
2. Riles tube
3. Catheter insertion
4. Inguinal hernia
5. Portal hypertension
6. Clinical anatomy of pelvic viscera

Head & Neck

1. Examination of facial muscles
2. Evisceration of eyeball (in fresh Non-embalmed cadaver)
3. Tracheostomy
4. Clinical anatomy of Thyroid gland
5. Clinical anatomy of Larynx

Neuro-anatomy

1. Clinical anatomy of Spinal cord
2. Clinical anatomy of Brain stem
